



# Downloading eBooks for Kindle, Kindle Touch, and Kindle Paperwhite.


Borrowing eBooks from the library for your Kindle is easiest with a computer or tablet. Start out by going to our eBook Catalog at [www.efiles.rcls.org](http://www.efiles.rcls.org) and click Sign in.




Fill in your Library card Number and PIN (the last four digits of your phone number by default) & click Sign in.



Click Advanced Search in the upper right corner of the page.




Use the drop-down arrow next to All Formats to select Kindle Book and hit the Search button. Kindle, Kindle Touch, and Kindle Paperwhite will only work with Kindle Book format eBooks.




The books we get after searching are all compatible with our Kindle Devices.


The Book or Head Phone Icon in the upper right corner of each title indicate the title's availability. Dark icons mean the book is available to borrow, while a light gray icon means the title is currently checked out. You can sign up for the waiting list for books that are currently checked out, and you'll be notified by email when they become available.




Find a title you'd like to borrow, and click on it. The next screen has some details on your title. Click Borrow.




At the next screen, click the Download button and click the tick box next to Kindle Book. Then click Confirm & Download. Kindle, Kindle Touch and Kindle Paperwhite will only work with eBooks in Kindle Book format.



A new tab will open and take you to Amazon.com. Click the Get library book button on the right.



You may be prompted by Amazon to log in to your account. Log in with the email you have associated with the Kindle you'd like to read your library book on.  
Choose the Kindle you'd like to send the book to with the drop-down box, and click Continue.



You're Done! Boot up your Kindle, connect it to your WiFi, and your title should download!
